Dear Mr. Galligan:

Pursuant to your verbal request received on Friday, January 16, 2015, I hereby give permission for Jim Vernon of Nobis Engineering to visually inspect the property known as "The Birches" at 100 Long Ridge Road, Carlisle, MA under the following conditions, as discussed:

1. I or a representative of my choosing must accompany Mr. Vernon.
2. A condition of this granting of permission is that the Town's agent, Mr. Vernon, is a Special Municipal Employee. You have represented that Mr. Vernon will be under contract prior to the inspection and you have confirmed that he is considered a Special Municipal Employee as the law allows. As a Special Municipal Employee, liability protection is afforded by the Town of Carlisle for claims including injury.
3. Abutters, agents of other municipal boards, and the general public are not invited nor will they be granted permission.
4. Board of Appeals member Steve Hinton may accompany Mr. Vernon, as he is also is a municipal employee.
5. The approval is only good for one day, January 23, 2015. The inspection time shall be limited to no more than 120 minutes.
6. The inspection will be visual only including "kicking the dirt" but without any measurable or identifiable disturbance of the surface of the land and without any ground exploration.
