Dear Members of the Board,

I am writing on behalf of my client, Lifetime Green Homes, LLC, to provide the Carlisle Zoning Board of Appeals a response to its request for a further extension of time in which to conduct its public hearing relative to the above referenced project. As you know, applicable state regulations require the Board to close a public hearing for a Comprehensive Permit 180 days after opening the hearing. Furthermore, recall that the Applicant has previously granted a number of extensions to the Board.

The purpose of the public hearings is to allow the Applicant and any interested parties to submit information and data relating to the Project and to allow the Board time to compile information and data in order to render a decision. The Applicant at this time has submitted all information they feel is necessary to meet the legal obligations pursuant to Massachusetts General Law Chapter 40B and the rules promulgated thereunder, and feels that the public, the Board, and other town boards and departments have had more than ample time to submit any information. Furthermore, as you are aware, while the Board is required to close the public hearing within the applicable statutory timeframe, it still has an additional forty (40) days to render a decision. In light of the extensive public hearing process to date, and given the separate statutory timeframe for rendering a decision, the Board will have ample time to issue a decision without the need for additional and unnecessary public hearings. However, that said, my client has instructed me to grant the Board an extension of the public hearing timeframe through June 29, 2015.
