

PLANNING BOARD

Meeting 10-12-71

Present: Mssrs. Herndon, Hosmer, Macone, Jones, and Thomson.

1. The old Congregational Church on the Town Common is for sale for \$85,000 (originally offered at \$40,000 three yrs. ago). It may need heating, sewer, and water work. The Board voted to investigate further. Potential use is for town offices and other municipal uses, if the new proposed library is not built.
2. Green Cemetery needs expansion. Davis land is on market (bounds seem to be in some dispute). P.B. recommends Selectmen urge town to buy more cemetery land. Clerk to so advise Selectmen.
3. The Board noted Town Council notes on validity of large acre zoning in Penna, where it was held invalid. Potential future Mass. problem.
4. New members needed on P.B.: one to replace Joe Macone who is not running for re-election in 1972. Gerald Jones will stand for election in '72, after having finished David Spauldings term of office. There are two positions to fill in '72, one in '73, and two in '74.
5. Voted to submit budget request for next fiscal year of \$1800, down from prior \$2100.
6. Sanford's Fiske St. plan signed off - approval not required. Noted that lots 2 and 3 were combined. Lots 2 and 3 separately do not meet Zoning By Law standards. Chmn. Herndon signed for the Board.
7. Initial position of the Board is for plan "A" of the By-Pass Study to be supported by the Board. The Selectmen and then the Town, via public forum, to be advised after details completed and full agreement by all Board members.
