Minutes of Meeting 1-31-72: Meeting opened 8:05 P.M.

Present: Chmn. Herndon, Messrs. Evans, Macone, Thomson, and
Engineer David Perley.

1. Proposed 2.2 acre lot astride the Carlisle-Billerica line on East St., part of the Richard J. Robbins land, presented for approval. There was 250 ft. frontage and all other requirements met. With the legend on the plan that partition was not allowed, P.B. signed off as P.B. approval not required. The Billerica P.B. must now sign off the plan before it can be recorded.
2. J&E Co. presented a signed Preliminary Plan for the Hosmer land on River Road. Due to conflicts with Concord, street names are to be restudied and resubmitted. The Board took the plan under advisement. Messrs. R. D. Nelson, Engineer, Finigan, and L. K. McNally, Jr. presented the plan.
3. A public hearing on the proposed two warrant articles will be held on 2-14-72 in conjunction with the regular meeting.
4. Indian Hill #2's road was discussed, since Deck House wishes to get the street approved. Possible problems with the culvert header, ditch bank erosion, and the stub ditch near old Autumn Lane terminus are to be reviewed by Mr. Perley. The erosion possibility is near the big curve with the guard rail on the outside of it.

The meeting adjourned at 9:55 P.M.
