MINUTES

May 9, 1977

Present: Cutter, Kulmala, Hannaford, Sauer

The minutes of the April 25 meeting and the reports of the April 21 Bylaws hearing and the April 25 Scenic Roads hearing on School Street were approved as read. The report of the April 28 Scenic Roads hearing on Russell Street was accepted with one change. In the first sentence of paragraph 3, "requiring a 20' right of way," should read "requiring clearing of 20'."

Frank Hannaford reported that at Hemlock Hill they are studying the catch basins for Laurelwood Drive on Milne Cove Road. It is proposed to install a manhole with a solid cover for maintenance of the pipes. Nickerson Foster will pick up the tab for this. The second layer of gravel has been applied up to station 10, 200' short of the intersection of the two subdivision roads. Discussion led to asking where is the list of suggested names for subdivision roads. The Historical Commission will be contacted about this.

Goal planning was next discussed. Kay Kulmala presented a preliminary list of suggestions including open space planning, center planning, housing planning as major headings with a miscellaneous list touching on scenic roads, porkchop lots, road stubs, special permits and Valleyhead. On scenic roads Frank Hannaford suggested the Board should check to see what other roads besides School Street had been omitted from the list. He also referred to an earlier suggestion that a map be made from the Assessors' maps so open space can be seen.


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Kay Kulmala will prepare a more detailed list which can be added to and upon which board members can indicate which items they feel should be given priority. This will be discussed fully at the May 23 meeting. Associate members should be urged to attend.

It was decided to invite representatives from Town Boards and, through a press release, the general public to attend the June 13 meeting for their input on establishing Planning Board priorities.
