

**WARRANT
SPECIAL TOWN MEETING – APRIL 11, 2011
THE COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS**

Middlesex, ss.

To either of the Constables of the Town of Carlisle in the County of Middlesex:

GREETINGS

IN THE NAME OF the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the inhabitants of said Town, qualified to vote in elections and town affairs, to meet at the Corey Building at 150 Church Street in said Carlisle on Monday, the Eleventh of April next, at seven o'clock in the evening, and thereafter continuing from day to day until completed, then and there to act on the following articles:

ARTICLE 1 – Rescission of Community Preservation Act: To see if the Town will vote to rescind the acceptance by the Town of the Community Preservation Act, Sections 3 to 7 of Chapter 44B of Massachusetts General Laws, as set forth below and further to place such rescission if approved by the Town Meeting on the ballot for acceptance by the voters of the Town at the next qualifying Town or State election, or take any other action related thereto. (BOARD OF SELECTMEN)

ARTICLE 2 – Increase CPA Surcharge: To see if the Town will vote to amend the vote taken under Article 1 of the Special Town Meeting held on April 10, 2001, to increase from two percent (2%) to three percent (3%) the surcharge authorized thereunder, as provided in M.G. L. c. 44B, §§3 and 16(a), or take any action relative thereto. (BOARD OF SELECTMEN on behalf of Citizens)

And you are directed to serve this warrant by posting a true and attested copy thereof at the Town Hall and at the Post Office in said Town of Carlisle at least fourteen days prior to the time of holding said meeting.

THEREOF FAIL NOT and make return of this warrant, with your doings thereon, to the Town Clerk, at the time and place of holding the meeting aforesaid.
