MINUTES OF MEETING 7-13-70  
8:10 P.M. SELECTMEN'S OFFICE

Present: Chairman Herndon, Macone, Evans, Spaulding, Clerk Thomson.

1. Aerial survey was discussed at length. Present incomplete survey of town will be redone without any effect on the contract. Photos of the first incomplete survey are available. Thomson and Allan Benjamin will confer on need to purchase a portion of same for study purposes re town center traffic patterns and by-pass. Up to \$120.00 can be spent on purchase of photos. Scale and area to be covered to be decided by Benjamin's needs.
2. Correct and complete survey will probably be done next spring by aerial photo company.
3. Center traffic study project being worked on by Benjamin during week of 7-15. Benjamin to meet with sub-committee on by-pass after draft complete to discuss his conclusions.
4. Site plan approvals by Selectmen, Board of Appeals, or other agency, with consent approval by Pl. Bd., as practiced in Canton and Sudbury, may have merit for Carlisle. Ch. Herndon will touch base with Selectmen on this.
5. Joe Macone has suggested a traversing street between Rt. 225 starting near the library and ending on church street. On this side street would be constructed, using as much town owned land as possible, a post office-dispatching center for P.O. and Town use. P.O. to lease from town. Extra space to be leased from town during heavy P.O. season of Christmas, and other possibilities discussed. Idea to be pursued by Macone and discussed by Ch. Herndon with Selectmen. This project could solve some of the traffic problems at the town center due to P.O. being located there.
6. Virginia Farm Rd. resurfacing to wait until side grading now in progress is completed. Mr. Perley to review later.
7. Adjournment at 9:45 P.M.
