MINUTES OF MEETING HELD DECEMBER 14, 1970, 8:05 PM.

PRESENT: Mssrs. Chmn. Herndon, Hosmer, Evans, and Clerk Thomson.

1. The Board reviewed the street-numbering-project with Don Fox and decided to reverse the June 1970 decision of the Board and place odd numbers on the left and even numbers on the right side of streets radiating from town center, or from the junction of a dead-end street with another road. The Police Chief concurred, as did Fire Chief.
2. Don Fox received the revised draft of the new town street map from Thomson and the Board reviewed, after which the Board instructed Don Fox to procede with the revisions as shown. Thomson to review with Fox before publication. (This was donethe first week of January '71.)
3. Cal-Mor Realty (Joe Moore) requests the Board reduce his bond to \$3,000.00, and Board will do so if Mr. Perley concurs. Items to be reviewed are: trench on East Riding Drive, bounds, grading fill (pull back). Board feels more than \$3000 may have to be hald back, but will go with Perley's recommendation.
4. Virginia Farme Road (Tri-Con Homes) road hot top and shoulder grading not finished. Must wait for spring to hot top, and Beard recommends finished grading before hot-topping because of possible damage to road surface by large vehicles during grading.
5. The Board reviewed warrant articles which will be drafted and mailed for final review by Chairman Herndon prior to next meeting.
