March 17, 1970 Meeting Minutes

Present: Chmn. Herndon, Messrs. Hosmer, Hicks, Macone, Evans, Thomson.

1. Moore & Mt. of Concord presented suggested zoning change for consideration and comment. They wished to rezone or obtain a special permit to have a warehouse and field test site for their products. The Board explored avenues they could take in attempting to obtain permission to locate in Carlisle, but did not offer any certainty of success.
2. The aerial survey is on for April at high water. Forrest Hicks is to communicate to the Survey people about the schedule for the project.
3. Street numbering is completed, but must be communicated to the townspeople. P.O. will distribute if they receive letters from the Board. Joe Macone is to review procedures Concord used and advise on details.
4. The DeBonas bond is still open and work has not been completed in the subdivision. Bob Thomson to write to Cosmos DeBonas and find out status, inform him of our position and ask when completion date will be.
5. Rework on Connally subdivision at Virginia Farm Rd. to be scheduled. Amount of rework and scheduling to be checked with Perley.
6. Board to review by-pass plans.
7. Terry Herndon re-elected chairman for 1971-72. Robert Thomson re-elected Clerk. Forrest Hicks elected Treasurer, replacing David Spaulding.
8. Recommendations to Selectmen: MAPC Rep. - Charles Evans
SILC Rep. - Nancy Penhume
(Note: Forrest Hicks to be Board Rep. to SILC.)
9. Solid Waste Disposal Committee Rep. - Terry Herndon.
Long Range Capital Outlay Committee Rep., Joe Macone.
