


Carlisle Recycles



Recycling & Transfer Station

Tuesday & Thursday 10am-7pm
Saturday 8am-5pm

Please separate carefully.

Place materials in proper bins.

If in doubt, ask the attendant.

Paper Products

Newspapers: Clean, dry in brown paper shopping bags.

Cardboard: Clean corrugated & sturdy items. Remove all plastic & wrappings. No waxed or plastic coated containers.

Glass Containers

Clean, separate by color.
No tops or rings.
Labels are OK.

Plastic Containers

Clean, no tops, labels OK.
Accept codes ♻ through ♻.
Separate by color.

Metal Cans

Tin: Clean, labels OK.
Aluminum: Clean, labels OK.

Salvation Army

Good clothing & small re-usable items.
Larger re-usable items can be left at compactor house.

Large Metal Items

Waste Oil

Tires

Yard Waste & Leaves

Should be composted at home.

Brush

Accepted in the spring.
Christmas trees in January.

Automobile Batteries

Leave at compactor house.

Carlisle Recycling & Transfer Station Regulations

The facility located on Lowell Street is intended for Carlisle residents and will only accept trash from residences located in Carlisle. Use is restricted to passenger cars and privately owned vans, pickup trucks and trailers with the required affixed identification sticker. Use by local commercial haulers is permitted so long as their service is limited to residents of Carlisle.

Hours of Operation

Tuesday and Thursday from 10am - 7pm
Saturday from 8am - 5pm

Sticker Fee

There will be a ~~\$20~~ ^{#15} fee for passenger cars, vans, trucks and trailers. All local commercial haulers are required to have each of their customers purchase a sticker and the hauler is responsible for having records of such sticker purchases on file at the Carlisle Police Station.

The sticker ~~is the property of the City of Carlisle~~. If lost or destroyed, a new sticker must be purchased at the original cost.

Sticker Purchase

Stickers may be purchased at the Carlisle Police Station on Lowell Street. Vehicle registration must be presented as proof of residency and type of vehicle. Stickers must be affixed to the vehicle's left front bumper.

Recycling and Trash Containers

Users may only deposit trash in the containers or area prepared for the material to be recycled or compacted.

Restricted Materials

Waste building material resulting from small repairs or remodeling by Carlisle residents on their residences is allowed.

Building materials from construction by contractors must be disposed of at commercial sites, not the Transfer Station.

Brush is accepted in the spring. Yard waste should be composted at home.

Prohibited Materials

Tree Stumps
Explosives
Junk Cars
Bulky Masonry
Hazardous waste, as defined by the Massachusetts Hazardous Waste Management Act, except on designated collection days.

Enforcement

Enforcement of these regulations will be the responsibility of the Department of Public Works with the assistance of the Carlisle Police Department.
