Dear Jeff and Doug:

As you know, James H. Vernon of Nobis Engineering, Inc. is currently working with the Zoning Board of Appeals to review the hydrogeology of the proposed development at 100 Long Ridge Road and the surrounding area. By letter dated February 13, 2015, I requested, on behalf of the ZBA, that you provide Mr. Vernon with certain information necessary to adequately conduct his review. To date, Mr. Vernon has not received the requested information, and you have not otherwise responded to the ZBA's request.

Accordingly, I am writing to request that you provide Mr. Vernon with the information requested in my letter dated February 13. Without in any way limiting the scope of the request contained in my prior letter, Mr. Vernon has specifically requested that he be provided immediately with the following information, which is believed to be in the applicant's possession:

- Boring and well construction logs for any borings and monitoring wells installed on the property to date.
- Water level measurements (under static conditions).
- Pumping test data (including rates, times, and water levels) from any pumping or slug tests done to date on monitoring wells or the existing bedrock wells that serve the existing house on the property.
- Surveyed elevations of measuring points on the monitoring wells.
- Map locations (surveyed or approximate) for the monitoring wells.
