The recent modification to the planned "Birches" development includes a public water supply. This is a logical development in the proposal. It was first emphasized by experts involved with reviewing the project concept given the density of occupants. It is very unfortunate to the review process, that the PWS was not incorporated early on.

Meanwhile the town approved the original project as proposed so long as rigorous testing took place during construction to insure that water supplies will not be contaminated. There is nothing in these alterations which change the need to rigorously insure water safety during construction including the properties of the abutters.

Analysis to date indicates that under full occupancy, this development will likely contaminate the water supply of my property. Nowhere in the 40B law is a right given to one property owner to contaminate the water supply of several properties owned by others. It is therefore imperative that the permits for this property be given in such a way that insures scientific methods are employed during design and construction, rather than rely on guesswork.
