

The Friends of the Carlisle Council on Aging is the fundraising arm for the Carlisle COA. All monies raised by them are used to provide and support activities such as fuel assistance, food certificates for qualified seniors, transportation with the COA van, cultural and educational programs, exercise classes, line dancing, monthly breakfasts and luncheons and other social gatherings. They support and encourage intergenerational programs for the enrichment of all.

The Friends also provides funds for wellness clinics (such as blood pressure, flu and podiatry), for the purchase of large print books and audiotapes for the library, and for special projects for the health and well-being of Carlisle seniors. It also donates to the Town Elderly and Disabled Fund for property tax deductions.
