NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

In accordance with the provisions of Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 40, Section 15C, Chapter 87, Section 3, and the Carlisle General Bylaws, Article XII, the Carlisle Planning Board and the Tree Warden will hold a virtual joint Public Hearing on May 24, 2021 at 7:00 p.m. via remote meeting teleconference on the petition of Tamara Murray, 330 Lynnway, Suite 107, Lynn, MA 01901 to remove approximately 35 feet of stone wall located along the right of way adjacent to Assessors Map 19 Parcel 39-X on Curve Street, a Scenic Road. The stone wall removal is necessary to construct a driveway to a single-family home. In addition, a 24" and a 20" pine tree need to be removed in order to construct the driveway entrance. The 24" pine has already been removed, but the stump is visible.

The proposed stone wall opening is across the street and approximately 27' south of where Forest Park Drive meets Curve Street. The alteration required will consist of removing 35'± of stonewall located approximately 6' south of utility pole number 19. The 24" pine and 20" pine are 20' and 28' south and east of utility pole 19. Said proposed action will require the written consent of the Planning Board and, for the tree removal, a permit issued by the Tree Warden.
