Notice of Public Hearing

Pursuant to Mass General Laws, Chapter 131, Section 40, Massachusetts Wetlands Protection Act, the Carlisle Conservation Commission will hold a Public Hearing on **June 18, 2020** at 7:30 PM on a Notice of Intent filed by the Carlisle Municipal Facilities Committee for the replacement of an existing failing septic system at 59 Morse Road and at 225 Lowell Street, Carlisle, MA, Map 20 Parcel 1-0. A portion of the work will occur within the 100-foot Buffer Zone to Bordering Vegetated Wetlands.

Public Participation will be via Virtual Means Only - Pursuant to Governor Baker's March 12, 2020 Order Suspending Certain Provisions of the Open Meeting Law, G.L. c. 30A, §18, and the Governor's March 15, 2020 Order imposing strict limitation on the number of people that may gather in one place, this meeting of the Carlisle Conservation Commission will be conducted via remote participation. The public may participate in this meeting via Remote Participation: A website for the meeting will be provided on the Conservation Commission Agenda posted on the Town's website at least 48 hours prior to the meeting.
