Notice of Public Meeting

Pursuant to Mass. General Laws, Chapter 131, Section 40, Massachusetts Wetlands Protection Act and the Carlisle Wetlands Protection Bylaw, the Carlisle Conservation Commission will hold a Public Meeting on July 15, 2021, at 7:30 pm on a Request for Determination of Applicability filed by Jonathan & Allison Beakley for squaring off and expanding the back yard of an existing single-family home with work in the 100-foot Buffer Zone of a Bordering Vegetated Wetlands at 533 West St. Map 17 Parcel 20 Lot 3.

Public Participation will be via Virtual Means Only - Consistent with Bill S. 2475, signed by Governor Baker: An Act extending certain COVID-19 measures adopted during the state of emergency, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health including holding public meetings through April 1, 2022 via remote means.
