Notice of Public Hearing

Pursuant to Mass General Laws, Chapter 131, Section 40, Massachusetts Wetlands Protection Act and the Carlisle Wetlands Protection Bylaw, the Carlisle Conservation Commission will hold a Public Hearing on **August 6, 2020** at 7:45 PM on a Notice of Intent filed by Sylvia Sillers for the construction of an addition to an existing dwelling, an associated driveway and replacement of the existing non-conforming sewage disposal system at 49 Concord Street, Carlisle. The work will occur within the 100-foot buffer zone to a Bordering Vegetated Wetland.

Public Participation will be via Virtual Means Only - Pursuant to Governor Baker's March 12, 2020 Order Suspending Certain Provisions of the Open Meeting Law, G.L. c. 30A, §18, and the Governor's March 15, 2020 Order imposing strict limitation on the number of people that may gather in one place, this meeting of the Carlisle Conservation Commission will be conducted via remote participation.
