Notice of Public Hearing

Pursuant to Mass. General Laws, Chapter 131, Section 40, Massachusetts Wetlands Protection Act and the Carlisle Wetlands Protection Bylaw, the Carlisle Conservation Commission will hold a Public Hearing on August 31, 2023, at 7:45 pm on a Notice of Intent Ecological Restoration Limited Project filed by Carlisle Conservation Commission, Dan Wells, Chair, Town of Carlisle for restoring a former cranberry bog to Wet Meadow and/or Emergent Marsh habitats by cutting to remove new woody growth, to mow, plant and seed to maintain the wet meadow or emergent marsh habitats, control invasive plants and work needed to level the crest of the Fiske Street Dike; the majority of the work is within wetlands resource areas or the 100-foot buffer zone at 750 Curve Street Map 30 Parcel 2-0.

Public Participation will be via Virtual Means Only. The public may participate in this meeting via Remote Participation: A website for the meeting will be provided on the Conservation Agenda posted on the Town's website at least 48 hours prior to the meeting.
