NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

In accordance with the provisions of Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 40, Section 15C, Chapter 87, Section 3, and the Carlisle General Bylaws, Article XII, the Carlisle Planning Board and the Tree Warden will hold a virtual joint Public Hearing on **September 13, 2021 at 7:30 p.m.** via remote meeting teleconference on the petition of Alison V. Pascarelli & Elizabeth Hudson Valentine, Trustees of the 566 Acton Street Nominee Trust, with an address of Choate, Hall & Stewart, 2 International Place, Boston, MA 02110, to remove approximately 17 feet of stone wall located along the right of way adjacent to Assessors Map 17 Parcel 24-3 on Acton Street, a Scenic Road. The stone wall removal is necessary to construct a common driveway to serve four single-family homes. In addition, a 12” oak and a 48” pine tree need to be removed to maintain sight lines.

The proposed stone wall opening is on the north side of Acton Street approximately 1,500’ west of Acton Street’s intersection with West Street. The proposed stone wall removal is directly west of an existing gate and opening in the stone wall. Said proposed action will require the written consent of the Planning Board and, for the tree removal, a permit issued by the Tree Warden.
