7:45 p.m. Public Hearing for Certificate of Appropriateness No. 2022-08: 27 School Street, owned by the First Religious Society of Carlisle, for telecom equipment installation

The application was submitted by Ed Pare, Jr., Esq. (Brown Rudnick LLC) representing DISH Wireless LLC to install new telecom equipment which includes the collocation of 3 panel antennas (1 antenna per sector) concealed within a segment of the existing steeple at the 69 foot above ground level antenna centerline height behind proposed radio frequency friendly fiberglass sheathing together with related amplifiers, cables, fiber and other associated antenna equipment, including without limitation, remote radio heads, surge arrestors, and global positioning system antennas with associated electronic equipment, and other appurtenances on proposed concrete pads located adjacent to the church building at ground level within a proposed fenced compound. The discussion will include the location and appearance of the cable tray/chase from the fenced compound to the roof eave among other possible related topics.
