Notice of Public Hearing

Pursuant to Mass General Laws, Chapter 131, Section 40, Massachusetts Wetlands Protection Act and the Carlisle Wetlands Protection Bylaw, the Carlisle Conservation Commission will hold a Public Hearing on **August 6, 2020** at **7:45 PM** on a Request for Determination filed by W. Gordon Means & Lee F. Means, C/O Wind River Environmental (Paula Smith) for the work including grading associated with replacement of an existing septic system at 94 East Meadow Lane, Carlisle, MA. A portion of the work will occur within the 100-foot buffer zone to a Bordering Vegetated Wetlands.

Public Participation will be via Virtual Means Only - Pursuant to Governor Baker's March 12, 2020 Order Suspending Certain Provisions of the Open Meeting Law, G.L. c. 30A, §18, and the Governor's March 15, 2020 Order imposing strict limitation on the number of people that may gather in one place, this meeting of the Carlisle Conservation Commission will be conducted via remote participation.
