1. Review of 6/13/23 Meeting Minutes
  - a. *Motion: Courtney made the motion to accept the June 13, 2023, meeting minutes. Drew seconded. All in favor: Yes*
2. Special Inclusion Program Request for summer 2023
  - a. Two members of the community joined the meeting. Jim O'Shea, School Superintendent and Meredith Bielecki. Scott opened the discussion for any comments.
    - i. No comments.
  - b. *Motion: Courtney made a motion to create a Summer Fun special inclusion program that would begin in 2024. The goal will be to look into how we should handle special needs accommodations for future (2024+) Summer Fun programs, including, but not limited to, details such as registration slots, timing, paraprofessional usage, role of CPS, and special needs requests. Drew Seconded. All in favor: Yes*
  - c. *Motion: Courtney made the motion to pilot a special inclusion program for 2023 Summer Fun. This would enable the Rec Comm staff to accommodate special attendee(s) with an outside paraprofessional and assure safety and inclusion on short notice, provided they are already registered for Summer Fun. Note that this motion would simply confirm the pilot program already in place for Summer Fun 2023. Drew seconded. All in favor: Yes*
  - d. *Motion: Courtney made the motion to create an exception that would circumvent the 2023 Summer Fun waitlist for any special case scenarios, including special inclusion program pilot participants. Drew seconded. All in favor: No.*
  - e. Courtney stated that she is excited to start the special inclusion program for 2024.
  - f. The Pilot program in 2023 will help RecCom navigate the planning of the 2024 program.
