

TOWN OF CARLISLE COMMUNITY CHOICE POWER SUPPLY PROGRAM STATUS REPORT Q3 2019

Prepared January 2020

This report has been prepared by Colonial Power Group with information/data being provided by the Competitive Supplier and Eversource. The purpose of the report is to provide information about the Town of Carlisle's Community Choice Power Supply Program, which currently provides competitive power supply to approximately 1,500 consumers in the Town. The data provided by the Competitive Supplier is based on the calendar month invoiced (not meter read month). Therefore, the usage data is not available until 4 months after the month it was used. For example, power is *Used* in January, *Invoiced* in February, *Paid* in March and *Reported* in April.

The Town of Carlisle has chosen a 100% green product, which supports renewable energy as 100% of the power supply is offset with Renewable Energy Certificates (RECs), and an optional product that meets Massachusetts RPS requirements. At this time, 22 consumers have opted to use the optional basic product. The Town's aggregation savings are directly tied to the margin of savings between the Program's rates and Eversource's corresponding Basic Service rates as well as the level of consumption by participating consumers.
