## PLACEMENT OF PRIVATE SIGNS ON PUBLIC PROPERTY

- 1. This policy shall replace the Policy on Placement of Signs in the Rotary adopted by the Board of Selectmen on May 7, 1991. This policy shall not apply to signs placed in the Rotary by the Town of Carlisle.
- 2. Only one private sign at a time, no larger than 2 feet by 3 feet, may be displayed in the Rotary with the approval of the Board of Selectmen/Town Administrator.
- 3. To request approval to place a private sign in the Rotary, a private party must submit a written application to the Board of Selectmen/Town Administrator that specifies the desired time period for the display of the private sign. The Board of Selectmen/Town Administrator will typically approve a display period not longer than one week, with a possible renewal for a second week. In order to place a private sign in the right of way in front of a residence or business, one must obtain the permission of the property owner.
