




## Where to recycle

| Location | MATERIAL               | ACCEPTABLE   | NOT ACCEPTABLE                                |
|----------|------------------------|--|---|
| 14       | Batteries              | Household, auto  |   |
| 8        | Books                  | Paperbacks, hardcover  |   |
| 16       | Brush                  | Chippable (April only)   | NO leaves or stumps                           |
| 13       | Cardboard              | Clean corrugated; clean uncoated boxes                           | NO wax cartons                                |
| 16       | Christmas trees        | January only   |   |
| 1        | Clothing               | Usable & rags; textiles; footwear                                | NO foam, cushions, rugs                       |
| 3        | Compost                | See table below  | See table below                               |
| 17       | Concrete, bricks       | Masonry  | NO slate, sheetrock                           |
| 15       | Construction Debris    | Asphalt shingles, sheet rock, lumber, plywood                    | NO paint                                      |
| 14       | Flourescent light bulb | Tubular or compact   |   |
| 7        | Glass                  | Clean bottles & jars, labels ok, no lids                         | NO windows, mirrors, drinking glass or plates |
| 10       | Large Items            | Sporting goods, furniture, garden supplies, appliances           |   |
| 11       | Mattresses             | Mattresses & box springs   |   |
| 14       | Mercury                | Hand to attendant  |   |
| 5        | Metal cans             | Clean, labels ok   |   |
| 9        | Metal Items            | All metals, painted, rusted, mixed with other materials          |   |
| 2        | Paper                  | Office paper, newspaper, junk mail, books, paper bags, magazines | NO wax paper, towels, plates, shredded paper  |
| 6        | Plastic                | Clean, labels ok   | NO plastic bags                               |
| 10       | Propane Tanks          |  |   |
| 4        | Redeemables            | Deposit bottles, cans  |   |
| 8        | Reusable items         |  |   |
| 10       | Tires                  |  |   |
| 12       |                        | Boards < 4 feet  | NO paint                                      |

## Compost Items

| COMPOSTABLE  | NOT COMPOSTABLE                         |

| Paper & cardboard, even if food soiled, tissues, paper towels, napkins | Yard waste & grass clippings            |
| Coffee grounds & filters, tea bags                                     | Plastic (all)                           |
| Food waste, including:   | Diapers                                 |
| - Raw or cooked meat and seafood                                       | Cartons (juice, milk, ice cream, cream) |
| - Dairy  | Sanitary products                       |
| - Pasta, grains & bread  | Dog or cat waste, pet litter            |
| - Cookies, cakes & candy   | See table below                         |
| - Eggs & eggshells, bones  | Dead animals                            |
| - Fruits, vegetables & nuts  | Laundry lint & dryer sheets             |
| - Cooking oils & grease  | Take-out food containers                |
| Other organic material, including:                                     | Take-out cups                           |
| - House plants & flowers   | Pizza boxes                             |
| - Wood: toothpicks, popsicle sticks                                    | Textiles                                |
| - Wood: Wine corks, sawdust  | Wax paper                               |
| - Stove, grill & fireplace ash   | Produce & meat packaging                |
| - pet food, hair, fur, hamster bedding                                 | Chemically soiled paper                 |
